## *JUSTICE SYSTEM Monthly Changes – March 2016*

### Adult Jail Incarceration

- **Bookings increased** from 7,450 in February to 8,109 in March.
- **Releases increased** from 7,366 in February to 8,183 in March.
- The **Average Daily Population (ADP) decreased** from 7,237 in February to 7,210 in March.
- The **Pretrial ADP decreased** from 5,426 in February to 5,391 in March.
- The **Sentenced ADP increased** from 1,610 in February to 1,620 in March.
- The **Agency Hold ADP decreased** from 162 in February to 161 in March.
- **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) at release increased** from 26.8 in February to 29.3 in March.
- The **ALOS in days for Pretrial increased** from 7.4 in February to 10.6 in March.
- The **ALOS in days for Sentenced increased** from 23.1 in February to 23.7 in March.
- The **ALOS in days for Agency Holds increased** from 76.3 in February to 77.1 in March.

### Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

- **New Criminal Case Filings increased** from 2,530 in February to 2,941 in March.
- **Case Terminations increased** from 2,181 in February to 2,568 in March.
- **The resulting Clearance Rate was 87.3%.**
- The **Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 10,174 in February to 10,118 in March.
- **Regional Court Center filings increased** from 1,220 in February to 1,463 in March.
- **Early Disposition Court filings increased** from 1,006 in February to 1,090 in March.
- The **Number of Trials Completed decreased** from 66 in February to 59 in March.
- The **Trial Rate was 2.0%.**

### Justice Court Filings

- **DUI Filings increased** from 585 in February to 668 in March.
- **All other Criminal Traffic Filings increased** from 3,281 in February to 3,479 in March.
- **Civil Traffic Filings increased** from 10,920 in February to 10,991 in March.
- **Eviction Action Filings decreased** from 4,268 in February to 3,991 in March.
- **Total Filings increased** from 26,155 in February to 27,259 in March.

### Adult Probation

- **Adult Standard Probation Supervision increased** from 23,858 in February to 24,012 in March.
- **Adult Intensive Probation Supervision decreased** from 1,038 in February to 1,010 in March.
- **Adult Unsupervised Probation Supervision decreased** from 4,148 in February to 4,053 in March.

### Juvenile Detention and Probation

- The **Average Daily Detention Population increased** from 165 in February to 166 in March.
- The **ALOS in Juvenile Detention decreased** from 19.5 in February to 16.6 in March.
- **Juvenile Standard Probation decreased** from 1,753 in February to 1,750 in March.
- **Juvenile Intensive Probation increased** from 196 in February to 197 in March.
- **Monthly commitments to Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections decreased** from 15 in February to 11 in March.





# Number of Dependency Petitions Filed Juvenile Court





# Recidivism Risk Score (RRS / "Proxy") Distribution Among Current Jail Population:










# Average Daily Jail Population




# Average Daily Jail Population by Type




# Average Daily Jail Population by Gender




# Pretrial Average Daily Population




# Pretrial Felony Average Daily Population




# Pretrial Misdemeanor Average Daily Population






# Average Daily Jail Population of City Offenders



# Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail at Release




# Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail In Custody\*




# Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial and Sentenced Inmates




# Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates



## Average Length of Stay in Jail for Sentenced Inmates




# Average Length of Stay in Jail Agency Holds





# Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances




# Superior Court Criminal Case Filings and Terminations




# Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory





# Status of Cases After 180 Days




# Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter







# Justice Court Monthly Filings - Quarterly Average




# Adult Probation Department Standard Supervision




# Adult Probation Intensive Supervision




# Adult Probation Unsupervised Population



# Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population




# Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay
