


DIAPER CHANGING




1. Check supplies before bringing child to area. Place disposable towel (paper) on the diapering surface.



2. Place child on surface. Loosen clothing. **NOW**, put on disposable gloves. Remove soiled diaper, place in covered, plastic-lined container. Place soiled clothes in plastic bag, labeled with child's name. Store in plastic-lined container (for that purpose) until parent pick-up that day.



3. Clean child's bottom with disposable wipes. Discard wipes and table paper into the "soiled diaper" container.



4. Remove gloves, discard in "soiled diaper" container. If needed, clean hands with disposable wipe. (Limit touching surfaces and supplies when wearing contaminated gloves).



5. After removing gloves, put on clean diaper and re-dress the child.



6. Wash the CHILD'S hands, regardless of age, with running water and soap. Return child to activity area.



7. Clean and disinfect the diaper area and any soiled or potentially contaminated surfaces.



8. Wash **YOUR** hands with soap and water. **WASH AWAY GERMS!**
