MARICOPA COUNTY ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS FOR SEPTEMBER 2005

(Phoenix)-- The Environmental Services Department initiated legal action against the following facilities/establishments or individuals in September 2005 for violations of the Environmental Health Code.

Claxton Street Gilbert, AZ 85296	<u>Class 3 Misdemeanor Case</u> – Defendant was charged with violating the Maricopa County Environmental Health Code by failing to maintain a swimming pool to prevent the breeding of mosquitoes, a known vector of the West Nile Virus. An arrest warrant was issued because defendant failed to appear.
Mara Riddle 1543 W Michelle Drive Phoenix, AZ 85023	<u>Class 3 Misdemeanor Case</u> – Defendant pled guilty to violating the Maricopa County Environmental Health Code by failing to maintain a swimming pool to prevent the breeding of mosquitoes, a known vector of the West Nile Virus. Defendant received a fine of \$250, restitution in the amount of \$490, and 1 year probation.
Yvette LaJoyce Lewis and Michael Mararsch Nelson 9223 N. 12th Street, #103 Phoenix, AZ 85020	<u>Class 3 Misdemeanor Case</u> – Defendant was charged with violating the Maricopa County Environmental Health Code by failing to maintain a swimming pool to prevent the breeding of mosquitoes, a known vector of the West Nile Virus. An arrest warrant was ordered because defendants failed to appear.

The Environmental Services Department uses one of the following methods of legal action to enforce the Environmental Health Code.

- **A Permit Revocation** may be initiated against a facility/establishment that has not demonstrated compliance or has been found in violation of any applicable code. Permit revocation may also be initiated against trailer parks, hotels, semi-public swimming pools, and retail food establishments.

- **A Permit Suspension** may occur immediately for serious environmental health code violations, which pose a major health hazard. The facility/establishment would not be permitted to operate.

- **Citations** are issued for violations of the health code. The citation directs the defendant to appear for arraignment in Justice Court.

- **Cease and Desist Orders** are issued for serious violations of the environmental health code. The violation must be corrected immediately and a hearing may be requested. Disregarding the order will result in injunctive action in Maricopa County Superior Court.
