New Food Service Worker Study Guide! Versions in multiple languages are available online and in hard copy.

The Maricopa County Environmental Services department has updated its Food Service Worker Study Guide. The new version of the booklet reflects the latest changes in the newly adopted Maricopa County Food Code.

The Study Guide is available in multiple languages (English, Spanish and Chinese) and can be obtained in hard copy by visiting any of the department's locations or accessed online on the department's website. (*Please see info. further below*).

Food Service Worker Cards are required for any person who handles, prepares, serves, sells or gives away food for human consumption, including those whose duties are restricted to bussing tables or washing dishes. The rule does not apply to workers in facilities that handle food or beverages exclusively in a closed package or container. New workers must obtain their licenses within 30 days.
