- Tooth decay is the **most** common chronic disease in children
- Tooth decay is preventable
- Fluoride strengthens & protects children's teeth
- Teeth should be brushed twice daily with a fluoride toothpaste
- Children should visit a dentist by age one
- Proper oral habits should be started as soon as a baby is born
- Each family member should have his or her own toothbrush
- Family members should not share forks, spoons or cups at mealtime
- Healthy snacks are good for your body & teeth too!
- It is safe to visit a dentist when pregnant
- Good oral health is important for total body health

Fluoride Varnish Program

- Provides fluoride varnish from the first tooth through age 5
- Oral screening with written report of results provided to parents/caregivers



- Fluoride varnish is a safe, temporary coating painted on teeth with a soft brush
- Screening & fluoride varnish takes less than 5 minutes
- Fluoride varnish works to strengthen teeth & help prevent tooth decay
- Child can eat & drink following fluoride application
- Toothbrush kit provided to each child
